Join us for a fully interactive and exhilarating day starting in Glasgow City Centre. You will depart from the SECC pontoon beside the Crown Plaza Hotel (former Moat House) and then travel down the historic River Clyde bound for the Isle of Bute. You and your group will be picked up in our 10 metre Rigid Inflatable Boats (RIBs) that can travel at up to 55mph for your day's activities and returned by Helicopter. It is a truly unique way to see the area and have great fun in the process.

Mount Stuart, Britain's most spectacular Victorian Gothic house, is the Architectural fantasy of the 3rd Marquess of Bute and his architect Sir Robert Rowand Anderson. The stunning, mysterious interiors of Mount Stuart reflect the romantic and scholarly Marquess's passion for art, heraldry, astrology, mythology and religion. The art collection includes works by Old Masters, depictions of British royalty and arguably the finest privately held collection of family portraits in Scotland.

- 1145 Arrive at Mount Stuart (2 minute onsite bus transfer)
- 12-13 Enjoy a private guided tour of Mount Stuart House
- 1300 Sumptuous Fork Buffet lunch with Wine in the Purple sitting room
- 1430 Enjoy a leisurely walk amongst the grounds
- 1530 Fly back in style in the executive helicopters
- 1600 Arrive back in Glasgow City Centre Helipad
